Answer Key:

- Confirmed: The team has consistently demonstrated this attribute at an exceptional level. You want 80% of the answer to be confined to consider that as a high velocity team.
- Partially: There are indications that the team meets this criterion, though not uniformly.
- Unconfirmed: There is little evidence supporting the team's fulfillment of this criterion.
- Unknown: The information needed to determine this attribute is unclear or not available.
